- Both subject areas are taught in conjunction with the other due to the close subject topics and and content.



- In Key Stage 3 pupils build on the knowledge, learning and understanding that they have developed in their formative primary years.
- The curriculum in Years 7, 8 & 9 also provides new learning and helps to prepare pupils for the opportunities and challenges that they will face as they grow and develop in an ever changing world.
- During Key Stage 4, this preparation for life continues as the curriculum deepens (where appropriate) the levels of understanding that pupils have already gained at Pinewood.
- Extending pupils' knowledge ready for the ever closer reality of life after Pinewood by revisiting, re-enforcing and consolidating prior learning, alongside introducing new knowledge, concepts and skills.
