

Literacy

Pupils will be working through the ASDAN Developing Communication Skills Progression course. Every week they will have a lesson which focuses on each of the three areas of literacy; speaking and listening, reading and writing. The ASDAN modules being covered this term include:
Visiting a cafe-sharing stories of our experience, researching menus, how we communicate in a cafe (ordering/paying)
Eating out- researching eating establishments, comparing menus and costs.
Using the telephone- appropriate language and tone for formal/informal conversations.

Numeracy

This term in Maths pupils will be starting (year 10)/continuing (year 11) with the ASDAN TI numeracy progression course. This will include modules such as:
-Entertaining- making tally charts, taking orders, making drinks and working out costs of items.
-People in my group- sorting and organising by given criteria, calculating ages and ordering using numerical facts.
-Data Handling- completing tally charts, creating charts and analysing data.

Science

In Science pupils will be completing a WJEC module on "Making Useful Compounds".
Pupils will be learning about hazard symbols and about acids and alkalis-how neutralisation can make a variety of known salts.
They will also be making toothpaste and other useful compounds.

WRL - Community Independence

Pupils will be able to understand the difference between right and wrong. Be able to identify negative behaviours and criminal acts. Pupils will be able to demonstrate an understanding of the different types and nature of Public Institutions and Services in the UK. They will also know about one Public Institution or Public Service in their own local area.

WRL - Pathways
