Literacy

Pupils will continue to develop their speech and language through social interaction in the class setting; Zones of regulation, questions and answers, paired/group work and playing board games. In Phonics we will be focusing on digraphs such as; i.e., ae, 'th' and 'ch' sounds using the Smart Kids Phonics scheme. Pupils will do a weekly phonics word search. Pupils will participate in daily reading activities. Pupils will be reading fiction and non-fiction class books about animals such as We're Going on a Bear Hunt by Michael Rosen In writing pupils will be working on forming sentences accurately using colourful semantics, enhancing their writing using descriptive words by doing activities such as: taking objects from a mystery bag and describing what they feel like.

Humanities

Pupils will be learning about pets, having a visit from Kate Clark's pet dog, zoo keepers, camouflage in animals and comparing humans to other animals.

Numeracy

Pupils will be counting in 2's,5's and 10's and looking at patterns in multiplication. They will also be learning about Place Value and 2 digit and 3digit numbers. Pupils will play maths games weekly to develop their numeracy and social skills. In measure pupils will be learning how to use rulers and reading lengths in cm and metres.

Science

Pupils will be going to the Life Skills flat for two sessions a week where they will be learning how to do different activities independently such as how to use a washing machine, looking at clothes labels and personal hygiene; brushing and flossing teeth, washing hands and using deodorant as part of a healthy routine.

Creative Arts
