

Literacy

We will be developing our understanding of how to write recounts and stories linked to our theme. We will continue to work on our phonics and reading daily. We will be reading several texts linked to our theme; The snail and the whale The Owl and the Pussycat, Puss in Boots, Sloths Don't Run. Our class reading book is currently Fantastic Mr Fox.

Numeracy

We will spend the first half of this term focusing mostly on place value and ordering and comparing 2 digit numbers including money. We will use our knowledge to represent numbers in different ways, solve problems involving doubling and halving. Reasoning about problems involving money will also be a focus.

Science

This term we will be learning about animal classification and variation. We will sort and learn about vertebrates and invertebrates, starting with humans then moving onto fish, amphibians, birds, reptiles and mammals.

Humanities

Geography: We will be learning about physical and human geography, including coasts and mountains

History: This term our focus is learning about significant people in history. We are starting by creating a fact file about David Attenborough and finding out why he is famous.
