

### Literacy

Pupils will explore social signs in their setting and local community. Pupils will be supported to understand the meaning of the signs and demonstrate understanding of different social signs, showing ability to read different signs and take action. Pupils will present a project on different signs and demonstrate ways to follow the signs (verbal or actions). Links with safety and independence skills.

Pupils participate in a daily morning phonics sessions. Pupils will take part in reading lessons and have opportunities to explore books and develop speaking and listening skills.

### Numeracy

Pupils will be working towards a ASDAN qualification. Pupils will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes. Pupils will explore shapes in the environment and be encouraged to explore, identify and describe. Pupils will participate in a variety of activities to apply and extend their knowledge and understanding. Links with communication and observation skills.

### WRL - Community Independence

Work related learning covers 8 lessons per week. Lessons are designed to develop independence, life skills self-help skills, personal skills employment skills and skills to access the community.

### WRL - Pathways

Pupils will develop skills in following written and verbal instructions in a building and decorating context. Activities will include aspects of decorating a room: remove wallpaper, clean walls, prep walls, paint walls, wallpaper, paint skirting, put up shelves and pictures. Making and designing a product from a kit.

### PSHE & RSE

**PSHE & RSE:** Learning will be delivered focusing on personal values, assertive communication (including in relation to contraception and sexual health), relationship challenges and abuse. Lessons will include learning around how to communicate assertively and how to communicate wants and needs.

### WRL - Enrichment

Work related learning covers 8 lessons per week. Lessons are designed to develop independence, life skills self-help skills, personal skills employment skills and skills to access the community.

### PE & Swimming

**PE:** Pupils are learning how to use gym equipment safely in the fitness suite. Pupils will learn about the importance of warming up, stretching and the benefits of exercise. Pupils will have the opportunity to work outside and play small group games that develop co-ordination and balance.
