Literacy

In literacy our learning focus is expanding sentences in verbally and written form, moving from one to multi word answers. In reading, Class Wonder will be developing their understanding of Phase 2 and Phase 3 phonics in addition to expanding their sight-reading capacity.

Numeracy

In Numeracy this term we will cover the following topics: Multiplicative Reasoning, Number, Measure and Additive Reasoning. We will be learning about: Doubling and halving; sorting and counting objects; Comparison and measure; regrouping the whole.

Science

In science, our focus will be animal classification. We will be learning about the characteristics of animals and how to group them.

Humanities

Geography: In geography, we will learn about human and physical features and create our own maps. History: In history, we will look at a significant figure - David Attenborough. We will look at conservation and study extinct animals.
