Literacy

We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to the theme celebrations and carnivals. Skills will include writing captions, reading and following recipes. Our focus book will be Paddington At The Carnival by Michael Bond. We will sequence this story and write recounts. We will continue to work on our phonics and reading daily.

Humanities

Geography: We will be learning about where we live and looking at the countries which make up South America.

PSHE & RSE and Religion

PSHE & RSE: The focus will be on relationships. We will learn about consent, rights, risks and safety.

RE: Introduction to Sikhism beliefs, practise, celebrations and culture.

Numeracy
