

Literacy

This term Fry class will be looking at various fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts linked to our theme 'Celebrations': Supertato Carnival Castro-Pea and Carnival of the Animals. We will continue to work on our phonics and reading skills daily.

Numeracy

We will be focussing on Measure this term.
We will be extending our work on money and moving onto more complex calculations involving coin combinations and working out change. Our Number work will be additive reasoning and statistics.

Science

This term we will be starting by learning about sound and how it is produced. Key questions will include - What type of vibrations produce high/low pitched notes? We will also explore the sound health and safety.
Activities will include experimenting with how sound is affected by distance, space and other environmental factors.

Humanities

Geography: We will be learning about similarities and differences between regions in the UK, Europe and places further afield. Studies will include general map work and looking at cultural traditions.
History: This term our focus is on world history and learning about significant historical cultures. We will be starting with the Ancient Greeks and also learning about the origins of the Olympics.

Theme: Celebrations

Creative Arts

Art: We will be creating masks and looking at carnival arts and crafts.
Drama & Music: Our focus will be on exploring music and dance linked to celebrations e.g Samba and percussion

PSHE, RSE

PSHE & RSE: The focus will be on Self-worth, romance and friendships (including on-line) and relationship boundaries. We will also be looking at aspects of intimate relationships and sex education.
