

Literacy

This term pupils are accessing the community to develop their social communication and self-help skills. Pupils will be visiting a local café to apply skills learned in class around good manners, making requests, asking questions, finding out information and keeping themselves safe in a public space.

Numeracy

Pupils will be exploring collecting data. Pupils will be learning a range of ways to collect and present information. Pupils will explore different charts and graphs relating to favourite foods.

Science

This term pupils will be learning to plan an experiment. Activities will include experiencing different chemical reactions using different substances. Pupils will be learning to work scientifically and carry out a fair test. Pupils will learn how to present their results and write simple conclusions.

Work Related Learning

Community Independence: Pupils will be completing a unit about planting and understanding plant growth.

Pathways: Pupil will be learning about animal care, including trips to the farm after half term.

Enrichment: New craft activities. Pupils will explore craft techniques and processes.

PSHE, RSE
