

Literacy

We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to the theme celebrations and carnivals. Skills will include writing lists and invites, reading and following recipes, writing a news article and creating an Olympic sports booklet. We will write recounts on our class book 'Wyetta the Carnival Queen'. We will continue to work on our phonics and reading daily.

Numeracy

Over the term we will cover a range of mathematical skills. We will begin with geometry, looking at properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We will measure and estimate and learn which units of measure to use. We will also be practising our number skills in addition and multiplications and reasoning how we work it out.

Science

This term we will be learning all about sound. We will explore how sounds are made, how sounds travel to the ear, and experimenting with the pitch and volume of sounds. Sounds like fun! In gardening, we will sow seeds and look after crops.

Humanities

Geography: We will be learning about the physical and human geography of a region of the UK, a region in a European country and a region within North or South America.

History: This term our focus is learning everyday life in Ancient Greece including significant people, places and events.

Creative Arts

Art: Creating carnival masks filled with colour, feathers, ribbons and sequins.
