Literacy

Fictional text and poetry. Students will learn about the story structure, characterisation and plot alongside the use of vocabulary, grammar and pragmatics together to tell a story. Narrative and storytelling skills are a key focus and an important part of developing pupils' communication. Literacy sessions will incorporate development of handwriting, spelling and speaking and listening skills.

Numeracy

Over the term we will cover a range of mathematical skills. We will begin with number

Looking at number bonds application of different strategies, looking at properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We will measure and estimate and learn which units of measure to use for length.

Science

This term we will be learning about plants:
looking at different parts and their
functions, what plants need and
investigating the way in which water is
transported within plants.
We will also explore pollination and seed
formation.

Humanities

Geography: We will be learning about the physical and human geography of a region of the UK, a region in a European country and a region within North or South America.

History: This term our focus is learning everyday life in Ancient Greece including significant people, places and events.
