

Literacy

We will be following an ASDAN Towards Independence accredited course.

The course is entitled:

Developing Literacy skills: Progression

Pupils will complete a writing module on where they will write a book, a speaking and listening module on going to a café, and reading module on reading books and food and labels.

Numeracy

We will be following an ASDAN Towards Independence accredited course.

The course is entitled: **Developing Numeracy skills: Progression**

All sections of the numeracy course are based around using maths in real life experiences. This term's modules include: shape, space and measure and number.

Science

Our science curriculum this term is called: **Identifying common household chemicals**

Pupils will name chemical products, reading safety symbols, distinguishing between acids and alkalis through tests, observing chemical reactions, and learning about recycling and non-renewable sources.

WRL - Community Independence

We will be following an ASDAN accredited course entitled:
Healthy Living

Pupils will explore things that keep us healthy such as food and exercise and personal hygiene.

They will have hands-on experiences of taking part in exercises and cooking.

WRL - Pathways

We will be following an ASDAN accredited course.

The course is entitled:

Travelling in the local community
Pupils will learn about safety when travelling whether that be as a pedestrian, cyclist, or on public transport. Pupils will learn the rules and have practical experiences.

PSHE & RSE

The focus will be on respectful relationships and healthy lifestyles, focusing on families, parenting, conflict resolution, and balanced living. Lessons will teach students about diverse family structures, managing relationships and health, conflict strategies, and accessing support services.

WRL - Enrichment

Pupils will be doing Pinewood Outdoors. They will experience identifying plants and animals, and creating items from natural resources.

Pinewood Outdoors will take place on a Friday. Pupils can come to school dressed in Pinewood Outdoor kit (clothes you don't mind getting dirty and suitable for the weather).

PE

Pupils will develop skills in table tennis, table cricket, and gymnastics. They will focus on technique, strategy, balance, and movement fluency, culminating in performances and umpiring.
