

### Literacy

Students will explore and enhance their narrative skills with books like *Rosie's Walk* and *The Giant Jam Sandwich*, while also working on newspaper reports through *The True Story of the Three Little Pigs*. They will explore further narratives with *Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion* and *Last Stop on Market Street*.

### Numeracy

In numeracy, students will cover multiplicative reasoning, recognising patterns. We will begin by identifying the same and different. We will be progressing onto creating our own patterns independently deciding on the unit of repeat.

### Science

In science pupils will be exploring the properties, uses, and suitability of everyday materials and how their shapes can be changed through manipulation.

#### Communication

In these lessons we will focus on the pre requisites of communication, responding appropriately and tone of voice, through a range of games.

**Geography:** Students will study capital cities, settlements, and trade links, comparing London to other global cities, while using maps to explore physical features and landmarks in the UK, Europe, and the Americas.

**History:** Students will explore the Anglo-Saxons, including their invasions, daily life, beliefs, and key figures like King Alfred the Great.



## Wonder Curriculum Overview

**Spring Theme: Travel, trade and technology**

### Music & Drama

In music, pupils will study music from movie and film as well as looking at music from around the world.  
In drama, pupils will explore body language and facial expressions through travel-themed activities, acting out tourist scenarios and expressing emotions non-verbally.

### Technology

Pupils will use their wood technology skills to create boats. They will use skills such as cutting out wooden hulls, using a rasp to add a curve, using glass paper to smooth, join dowel mast to boat.

### PSHE & RSE

Students will learn to manage beliefs, challenge discrimination, and develop self-worth, while exploring mental health, wellbeing, and healthy coping strategies.

**RE:** In Spring, students explore identity, prayer, worship, and reflection, focusing on beliefs, sacred stories, and the role of prayer. They also learn about sources of wisdom, Easter's significance, and how beliefs shape behaviour.

### PE

Students will learn table tennis and table cricket skills, including serving, rallying, and team play. They will also practice movement to music, focusing on balance, body tension, and creating sequences with partner balances.

#### Pinewood Outdoors

Activities will include discovering the natural environment and using natural objects to create. We will be making items like natural object necklaces.
