

Literacy

Reading Comprehension and Text Features:

Understanding main points, gist, and details in various text types (e.g., instructions, descriptions, explanations, narratives).

Writing Skills and Sentence Structure: Writing simple and compound sentences using conjunctions and completing forms accurately.

Speaking, Listening, and Communication: Taking part in discussions, expressing feelings and opinions, making requests, asking and answering questions politely, and listening for gist and key information in conversations.

Numeracy

Pupils will continue working towards Entry 1/2 Functional Skills.

Topics include:

Read numerical information from lists
Sort and classify objects using a single criterion
Read and draw simple charts and diagrams, including a tally chart, block diagram/graph
2-D and 3-D shapes
Position and direction
Sort and classify objects
