Pearson/ Edexcel Functional Skills English accreditation

(Entry 1/Entry 2 level).

This term some of the topics include:

- sorting by alphabetical order.
- use of punctuation: full stops and capital letters
- grammar: use of proper and common nouns, adjectives and verbs.
- comprehension skills: identifying key information in written text.

Maths

Pupils are working towards the Pearson EDEXCEL Functional Skills Maths accreditation (Entry 1/Entry 2 level)

This term some of the topics pupils will be covering are:

- addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers.
- money skills-coin recognition and simple monetary transactions.
- analogue and digital 12/24hr clocks.
