

English

Students are doing daily phonics lessons and reading daily to an adult. Students are reading different books around the topic "All about me". Students are creating and writing a book all about themselves to share with another class and/ or adult.

Maths

Students are first learning about number: odd and evens, one fewer and one more and adding and subtracting. Students will also be learning about measures focussing on length, additive reasoning- doubles and near doubles and geometry specifically shape.

Science

The topic students are learning about in the Autumn term is 'Busy Bodies'.

Students are learning about teeth, how to look after teeth, the digestive system, muscles and the skeleton.

History

Students are learning about the Romans and finding out who they were and what impact they had on British society.

Geography

Students are learning about the United Kingdom; capital cities of UK and finding the countries on maps and in atlases.



Einstein Class Autumn Curriculum Overview

RE

Students will be learning about the religions: Christianity, Buddhism and Hinduism.

Art

Students are learning about Roman mosaic patterns and creating their mosaic patterns.

PSHE & RSE

Students will be learning about healthy and unhealthy friendships, assertiveness, substance misuse and positive and negative peer influences.

Drama

Students will be learning about the Arts Award and using their creativity around this.

Music

Students will be learning about percussion instruments, focussing on body percussion and glockenspiels. They will use instruments to perform to an audience.
