English

This term we will be working on producing a personal narrative, taking inspiration from a key text that supports our history topic of the Romans. We will be weaving in grammar lessons to support the construction of the final pieces of work.

Daily Phonics lessons will continue to use SMART KIDS The Code scheme. Individual 1:1 reading will also be maintained.

Maths

This term's topic will be working on number and place value, finding comparisons, counting on and back from a given number.

Next steps will be adding, subtracting and finding part or a whole of a number. We will also concentrate on using money, making combinations and finding change.

Science

The first part of the term will be studying teeth and skeletons. Looking at different types of skeletons, muscles and their functions in the body.

The next focus is studying the life cycles and processes of animals and humans.

History

We will be studying The Romans looking at how they invaded and settled in Britain. We will then go on to study the Vikings- their way of life and delving into the Norse Gods.

Geography

We will be studying the United Kingdom in terms of countries and cities along with natural features. We will go on to look at Europe including countries that make up continents.
