

### Literacy

We will be focusing on:

- Narratives: what makes a narrative and writing our own narratives.
- Invitations: Reading about Diwali and writing invitations for our own event.
- Reports: Reading about Slime and writing a report on a chosen topic.
- Poetry: Reading various poems and creating our own poetry.

### Numeracy

Over the term we will cover a range of mathematical skills. We will begin with number - adding and subtracting, measure (length and height), additive reasoning, and finishing off with geometry (shape).

### Science

This term we will be learning about different bodies, for example the human body and the digestive system. We will be conducting and evaluating different experiments in regards to our bodies and how things move inside our bodies and different names for our organs.

**Geography:** We will be learning all about the United Kingdom: countries, regions, counties, flags, food, and landmarks. Then using maps to label our world and locate various places on a map.

**History:** This term our focus is learning about the Ancient Romans, when and where they lived and what they contributed to English history.

## Oliver Class Autumn Curriculum Overview Theme: Busy Bodies



**Art:** Making and creating fun and crafty objects (i.e. mosaics, Roman shields, etc.) that coordinate with our Autumn theme of Busy Bodies.

**Drama & Music:** Learning about how to make music and write our own music, and different ways to express ourselves.

**PSHCE:** Learning about healthy and unhealthy relationships in various settings. How to be aware of healthy and unhealthy situations around us.

**RE:** Various religious beliefs and practices, symbols, and traditions, followed by a unit on justice and fairness and what that looks like in different religions.

**Technology:** First half term students will be focusing on Food Tech - how to be safe in the kitchen and learning how to make various foods (i.e. danish pastries, pizza, etc.). Second half term students will be in Design Tech learning how to be safe while using various building tools and building different projects.

**PE:** Students will be working on various athletic activities such as hockery or netball and will working to improve their gross and fine motor skills.

**PO:** Pupils will be learning about the outdoors and first aid and will hopefully get the chance to travel offsite to do various outdoors activities.
