Geography

Theme: Busy Bodies



Design Tech (Autumn 1)

Pupils are designing and making fidget toys; sawing wood and using a sewing machine as part of the whole process.

Computer Science (Autumn 2)

Photography - taking and using pictures from iPads and other digital devices (downloading & sharing)

Science

We will learn about the different types of human teeth and their simple functions.

Pupils will study the digestive system, understanding the role of the mouth, stomach, intestines and other parts in breaking down food and absorbing nutrients.

We will also look at skeletons and muscles, recognising how they support the body, protect vital organs and enable movement.

Art

We will make Roman shields, coins, jewellery and create Viking ships

Drama

Our focus will be on mask work and developing drama skills through movement, storytelling, and improvisation.

Music

We will explore body percussion and learn to play the Glockenspiel.
