

### English

Students will focus on writing to inform through reading and exploring the book, Big Blue Whale By Nicola Maitland.

They will then focus on writing to entertain through reading and exploring Julian is a Mermaid by Jessica Love

Students will participate in a weekly Attention Autism session and Colourful Semantics activities and daily phonics and reading activities.

### History

As part of understanding British History students will be learning about The Vikings and the impact they had on British History

### Geography

Students will use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.

### PSHE & RSE

Students will learn about respectful relationships focussing on families and parenting, healthy relationships, conflict resolution and relationship changes.

### RE

In RE students will focus on prayer, worship and reflection in the Christian, Buddhist and Hindu religions.

### Maths

To begin with students will focus on Multiplicative Reasoning; recognising patterns in numbers and demonstrating an understanding of doubling and halving simple whole numbers. Students will also begin to look at sharing objects and numbers into equal and unequal groups.

Students will then consolidate skills of telling the time and using number.

### Science

The topic is Creatures Great and Small. Students will learn about how animals and humans get nutrition from what they eat and that plants make their own food.

They will also begin to learn that living things can be classified in a variety of ways.

### RE
