

English

To start off our English coverage this term we shall be exploring poetry by Julia Donaldson. The narrative text we will be focussing on comprise of 'Puffin Peter'. The second half term will have us focussing on instructions and recipes, using inspiration from texts such as 'How to wash a woolly Mammoth, and 'Gruffalo Crumble'.

Maths

Maths lessons will allow us to continue to embed and apply our prior learning to areas of multiplicative reasoning and comparison of amounts.

After the half term break our focus will move on to time and additive reasoning and combining and subtracting amounts.

Science

Science lessons will focus on the biology strand, naming a wide variety of animals types and their characteristics and exploring animal diets and food chains, introducing scientific vocabulary such as carnivore and herbivore. We shall also explore plants, their structure and which ones we can find in our local area.

History

History lessons will focus on changes within living memory using the reign of Elizabeth II to Charles III and how explore changes to national life.

Geography

In Geography we shall be exploring the world's continents and weather patterns, before moving on to volcanoes!

Spring Curriculum Overview 'Dino-Roars'

RE

In RE, we will continue to explore Christianity and Judaism and the similarities and differences between them, through the exploration of artefacts, acts of worship and Easter.

Art

Through our topic of Dino-Roars we will be engaging in a wide variety of dino themed activities such as sculptures and collages.

PSHE & RSE

PSHE will allow us to explore identities, diversity and prejudice and stereotypes. We will then move on to exploring bullying, the effects of it and how to respond.

After half term, we will be exploring puberty and then using the NSPCC guidance and how to keep ourselves safe.

Drama

Drama sessions will focus on oral storytelling of imagined scenarios and dinosaur themed activities, such as dinosaur movements and sound scapes.

Music

Music lessons will allow us to embed our knowledge of rhythm and tempo through drumming and the dinosaur

PE

The first half term will focus on developing our skills in movement and then target games. After the half term break the focus will be on indoor athletics and tag rugby.

PO

Pinewood Outdoors sessions will initially focus on simple first aid before exploring campcraft through tent pitching.
